Please note that some of the programs listed below have more than one program that **must be completed for certification to meet RAC Reflexology Foot Certification Program equivalency.*

1. **All American Reflexology Certification Board – ARCB - Approved Examinees with documentation of proof from ACRB**
2. **AOR – Association of Reflexology – United Kingdom** – All approved Schools registered under this Association
3. **All IFR Certificates** –International Federation of Reflexologists – UK (these courses are offered around the world)
4. **Aromatica School of Reflexology – ONT, Sarah Rankin** – Director
5. **British Columbia Institute of Holistic Studies – D Thomson-** Both Reflexology Courses approved
6. **Canadian College of Natural Healing – Ontario** – Must complete the Reflexology whole Program combined with the Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology
7. **Crane School of Reflexology – UK**
8. **Institute Quebecois De Reflexologie Integrale** Reflexology Certification Course
9. **International Academy of Natural Health Sciences Reflexology Certification Program - Ontario**
10. **International Institute of Reflexology** – Florida USA – Must complete Phase II and I combined with the Advanced Proficiency Workshop and documented Reflexology studies.
11. **International School of Reflexology and Meridian Therapy – Canada –South Africa** Complete Foot Certification Course
12. **Association Nationale De Reflexologie Du Quebec**
13. **Ontario College of Reflexology** – N101 Foot Reflexology Course only
14. **Oxford School of Reflexology Certification course - Ontario**
15. **South African Reflexology Association Approved Certified Members**
16. **The Pacific Institute of Reflexology (also known as Reflexology Ctr. of Vancouver) – BC** – Must have completed the Basic Holistic Foot Reflexology Course combined with the Advanced Holistic Foot Reflexology Course.
17. **Touchpoint Reflexology – BC** – Must complete Levels I, II, III combined (either the 5 month diploma program or the diploma program taught at Langara College).
18. **Universal College of Reflexology – Edmonton Alberta** – Must have completed the Basic Workshop Part I and 2 (Reflexology Certificate course) combined with all the practicum, and the Therapeutic Reflexology Certification Program and practicum to achieve equivalency with RAC.
19. **Reflexology Association of China** – Approved courses
20. **Natural Health Consultant Institute (NHC) Quebec** – All certified course applicants from the NHC are required to complete additional case studies to reach the equivalency of 60 case studies on the RAC Health Form. These will be submitted to and reviewed by the RAC PCT office before approval is granted.

21. Hanne Marquardt Certification Course – Must complete Level I, II, III of training program and full exams. Please note that the exam is optional by that school – RAC requires it to be completed and transcript submitted. Although the practicum format of the school does not meet 60 case studies as RAC prescribes, the format presented by the school and demonstrated to RAC meets approval.
